Chicken Coop Havilla Home, Nairobi, Kenya



The Chicken Coop at the Havilla Home began in 2013. The project provides nutritious protein in the form of eggs to the over 43 children living in the home, eggs which the home could otherwise not afford.

Chicken Coop Watoto Wema, Nairobi, Kenya



The Chicken Coop at the Watoto Wema provides healthy protein in the form of eggs for over 45 children. This is a substantial increase to their diet which is mainly based on starch and grains.

Aquaponics Tilapia Farm *Hogar de Amor, La Ceiba, Honduras*



The Aquaponics farm at the Hogar de Amor in Honduras is providing fresh veggies and healthy Tilapia for 30 children residing at the home. The project is reducing the home's food costs, allowing them to save money and hire a security guard, which is needed to keep the children safe due to the instability in the country.

Solar Panel Project *Mercy Mission, Bong County, Liberia*



The solar panel installation at Mercy Mission provides up to 12 hours of energy per day, saving the home the \$450 per month they would spend on their generator, which gave them only 4 hours of energy. By eliminating their energy costs, they are able to re-direct the funding to providing the children with three meals a day, as previously they could only afford one.

The water filters at the Havilla Home are providing clean, healthy water to the 45 children, and eliminating the occurrence of water borne illnesses that made many of the children sick and kept them from attending school. The water from their water tank was not clean and previously they spent hours boiling and treating the water.

The home previously had to purchase clean water from the city, which was very costly. As the home is located in the slums of Soweto, their only water source was from contaminated wells.

Clean Water Filters

Fiwagoh Home, Nakuru, Kenya



The filters at the Fiwagoh home are providing clean water for over 200 children and staff, an urgent need after their well became contaminated. The home no longer has to pay for clean water, and the children are free to drink as they wish, staying healthy and hydrated.

Dairy CowsFlying Kites Academy, Njabini, Kenya



This project is providing 3 dairy cows to the Flying Kites home in Kenya. The cows are providing at least 2 glasses of milk to 30 children in the home, which they could not afford to have before. In addition, the manure from the cows is being used for the biogas farm that provides fresh veggies to the children.
